***IKUEI Cross Method**: Our school offers a unique bilingual education named IKUEI Cross method where students study English once a day from Monday through Thursday and study all day in English on Fridays. All-Day English Program (the Intensive English Learning Program) was introduced in 2011 and has been achieving unprecedented results in bilingual education. During the morning session, students are divided into seven leveled classes to fine-tune their listening, speaking, reading, and writing skills. In the afternoon, they study social studies, science, math, and P.E. to study other subjects in English as if they are in local American schools.

There are many different language background students in our school. We offer leveled English classes and support the development of students' all-around English skills. The ESL program is designed for non-native English speakers who usually came from Japan. Each student is carefully placed in the level which will best suit their learning needs and abilities. The Language Arts program is designed for bilingual students to continue a native or near-native course of study in the English language.

Students are also offered a variety of American cultural events, which include a Halloween assembly and party, and various holiday song assemblies. Every semester, our students are given the opportunity to interact with American students from nearby schools. This exchange program encourages students to use English and forge friendship with native English speakers.

*EIKEN Examiners

EIKEN(英検:実用英語技能検定)is "Japan's most widely administered English-language proficiency testing program, with more than 90 million examinees since 1963. The EIKEN tests, which assess all four skills and include a face-to-face speaking component, are backed by the Japanese education ministry and recognized at thousands of institutions in Japan and internationally." Japanese Children's Society has been organizing the biggest site abroad on behalf of EIKEN Japan. About one thousand examinees gather to take the 1st stage written test 3 times a year in New York area. Those who passed the written test proceed to the 2nd stage interview test. The interview test is held on Sundays, three times a year.

We occasionally seek qualified candidates to join more than 30 examiners in NYC area who administer the EIKEN speaking tests. Upon successful completion of training, examiners are assigned to our test site as needed depending on the grade(s) they have been trained to administer and the number of examinees. We usually assign about 20 examiners to our test site each time. In order to become an examiner, please submit your resume and then we'll set up an interview. After passing the interview, you have to take the training course online. It will take about 40 minutes to 1 hour for each grade(1, Pre1, 2, Pre2, 3). Registration as an EIKEN examiner does not guarantee regular assignment to test site.
